BRANDYWINE, Maryland -- Memorial services for Robert R. Denny Sr., 81, of Brandywine, Md., were held at 11 a.m. today, Nov. 9, at Maryland Veterans' Cemetery in Cheltenham.

Mr. Denny died Saturday, Nov. 5, 2005, at his residence following a five-year struggle with cancer.

He was born Oct. 16, 1924, in Baxter to the late George and Emma Denny.

Mr. Denny, or "Bob," as he was known, was vice-president of Maryland Tobacco Packing Company in Upper Marlboro until he retired in 1986. Following his retirement, he worked several years as an advisor for the Maryland Department of Agriculture. He was a founding member of the Brandywine Volunteer Fire Department, a member of the American Legion and had been a past member of the Brandywine Lions Club. He was a veteran of World War II serving in Europe during and after the war.

He lived in Brandywine for more than 50 years. He loved spending time with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
