**Sam Denny**, age 76, of 1083 Long Branch Road, Lancaster, Tennessee died January 25, 2004 at his home after an extended illness. Born August 2, 1927, in Nashville Tennessee, Mr. Denny was the son of the late **Minnie Denny Self** and the late **Sam Bartlett**. He was reared in the Long Branch Community, attending Baxter Seminary and Tennessee Tech. Mr. Denny was a veteran of both World War II and the Korean War serving overseas with the U.S. Marine Corp. Mr. Denny was retired from Union Carbide Cooperation where he was field engineer at their Loudon County facility for over 30 years. Mr. Denny had a private land surveying practice that served East and Middle Tennessee. Mr. Denny was preceded in death by his wife of 49 years, **Hazel Lambert Denny**.

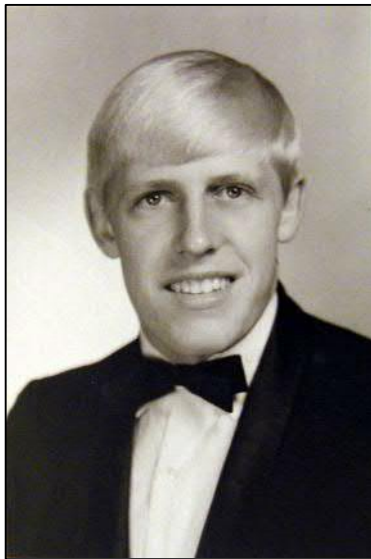

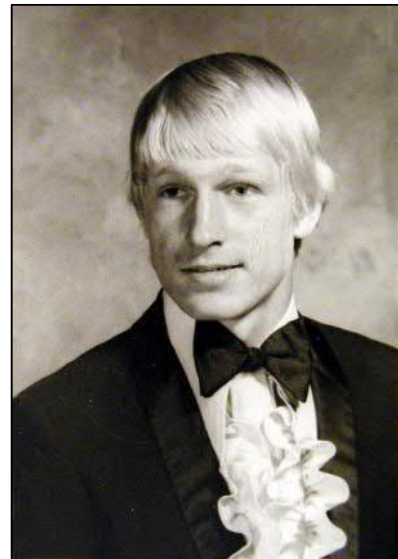

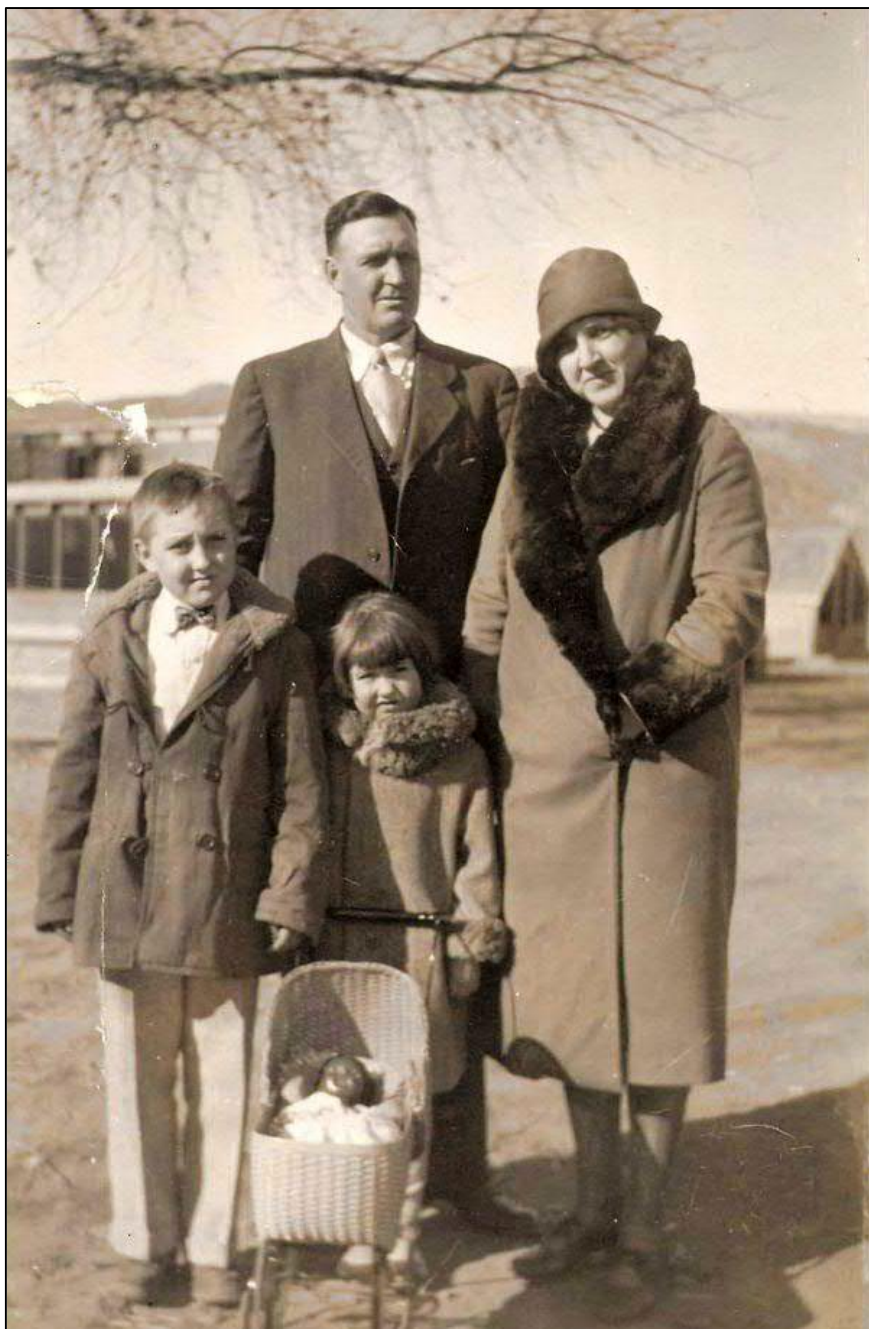

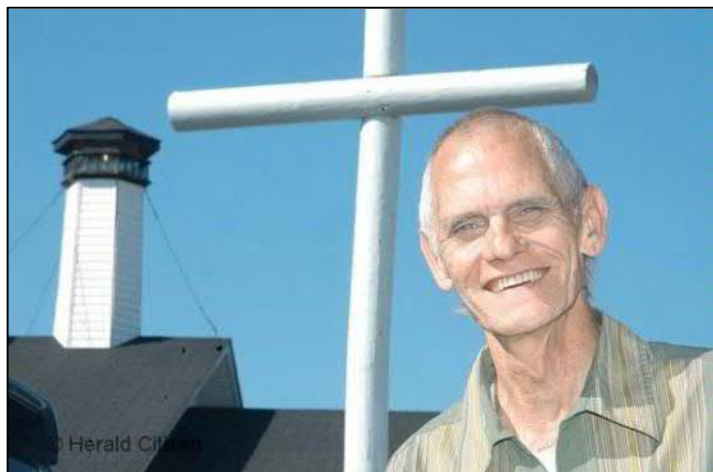
