Franklin D. "Felix" Scarlett, 43, former Baxter mayor, died unexpectedly Thursday morning from a heart attack at a local physicians' office.

Funeral services were held Saturday at Baxter at Baxter Methodist church. The Rev. Chester Stevens, the Rev. Edward Spiva and Denver Farley officiated. Burial was in Odd Fellows cemetery, Baxter. Hooper and Huddleston funeral home was in charge of arrangement,

Mr. Scarlett was mayor of Baxter for a two-year term beginning in 1952. He was operating a freight transport truck business at the time of his death.

A native of Baxter, he was a son of Franklin and Ella Hutchinson Scarlett. He was a veteran of World War II having served in the army. He was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the American Legion.

Survivors include his wife, Mrs. Ruth Edmondson Scarlett, two daughters, Judy and Phelissa Ann Scarlett and, two sons, Franklin D. III and Jimmy Scarlett all of Baxter, a sister, Mrs. Bethel Sutton, Nashville, two brothers, Woodrow Scarlett, Baxter, and Jesse Fain Scarlett, Belleville, Ill.
