MILITARY SERVICE:

My father Larry Denny Jr., born in Putnam County to Theopholis Larrimore Denny Sr., and wife Ollie May Davis, served in the United States Army during World War II.

He saw action while serving in the Philippine Islands. He was assigned to Company A 1st Battalion.

Headquarters and Services Group, and was qualified for Reconnaissance Crewman MOS 8733.

He was honorably discharged on January 16, 1946 and awarded: The American Theater Ribbon, the Good Conduct Ribbon, and the World War II Victory Medal.
