Jackson County, Tennessee was established in 1801 from Smith County, and Gainesboro, the county seat, was established as a town in 1817 and incorporated three years later. In 1801, when Jackson County was taken from Smith County, it was a part of the “Cumberland Settlement”, and it was organized for the convenience of the settlers of the “Cumberland”, who lived so far away from the available courts and the county seat. The names of the first settlers all appear on the records of the “Cumberland Settlement” and of Davidson, Smith, and Wilson Counties, all having been governed originally from the vicinity of Nashville. When first established, Jackson County included all of the present territory of Overton and Clay and parts of the other counties around it. Overton County was taken out of Jackson County in 1806. Clay County was taken equally from Jackson and Overton Counties on December 7, 1870.

Pg. 97: The Tennessee Central Rail Road: The Crawfords pioneered in railroading in the Upper Cumberland and continued to own the N&K until 1902. **Jere Baxter**, scion of a respected Tennessee family, trained in the law, dabbler in mining and rails, by connecting their small line with larger rail networks, completed the Crawford's work.

Baxter became the hero of the Upper Cumberland. Putnam Countians named a town for him, and in 1902, when a group unsuccessfully attempted to form a new county from portions of Putnam, Overton, Fentress, and Cumberland, its proposed naming it "Baxter."

Pg. 98: Beginning at the western edge of the county, the railroad company constructed depots at Buffalo Valley and Silver Point, where post offices and small settlements already existed. It designated Boma, named for the daughter of a railroad agent, a flag stop, but built no station there. **Mine Lick Depot, which took its name from a creek running through the area**, handles more business than any other station west of Cookeville. **Since the post office there was called "Ai,"** confusion resulted until 1902, when the community, post office, and depot all took the name, **"Baxter" in honor of the founder of the Tennessee Central Rail Road.** Double Springs, railhead for Gainesboro, Celina, and other communities to the north, was the last stop in the county before eastbound trains reached Cookeville.

Pg. 199: Crime, Pride, and Prejudice: Putnam County had its social and antisocial life. Because of small disagreements residents often held bitter grudges for years and even generations. Physical violence was common. "A bloody fight relieved the monotony of the unusually long reign of peace at Silver Point ...**Mine Lick (Baxter)** then had a little shooting affair, "reported the Cookeville Courier in 1893.¹⁰ The eighth civil district became known as the "Bloody Eight" because of the numerous knifings and shootings which occurred there, but lawlessness was not confined to any one area of the county. Moonshiners operated illegal stills in isolated coves and killed revenue agents who ferreted them out. "Toughs" stopped trains and demanded articles of baggage.

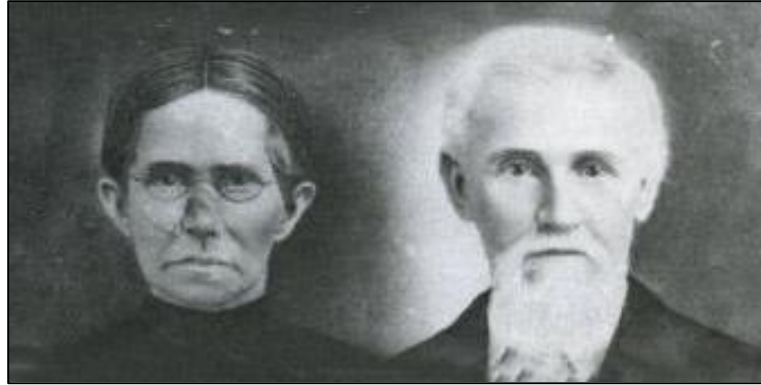

CONWAY AGREEMENT: Submitted by Dr. Louis Johnson

On 16 September 1854 the heirs and representatives entered into an agreement concerning the property of **Thomas Conway, deceased**, and this agreement is entered in Deed Book A, at page 61 of Putnam County, Tennessee. The Agreement is signed by **Elizabeth Conway, the widow of Thomas Conway**; James Welch and Sarah Welch; Jordan K. Harris and Tabetha Harris; **William H. Gentry** and **Lucinda Gentry**; **Lewis P. Conway**; W. J. Carr and Lucretia Carr; **G. W. Gentry** and **Emeline Gentry**. Witnesses were John Terry and **Silas W. Gentry**. On the same day and registered in Deed Book A pages 127-132 of Putnam County, Tennessee, 409 acres of land in several tracts on the waters of Cane Creek were sold to **William H. Gentry** and **Lucinda Gentry, his wife** by the following grantees: James Welch and Sarah Welch; Jordan K. Harris and Tabitha Harris; Lewis P. Conway; William H. Carr and Lucretia Carr his wife; **Green W. Gentry** and **Emeline Gentry**. Witnesses John Terry and **Silas W. Gentry**.

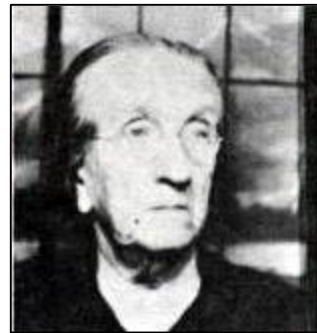

HISTORY OF THE CEMETERY

This hallowed ground was established as a U.S. Military Cemetery on Jan. 28, 1867. The Louisville & Nashville Railroad runs through the cemetery, dividing it into two nearly equal halves. The stone wall around the cemetery and the limestone archway at the front entrance were constructed in 1870. Among other outbuildings and structures, a speaker's rostrum was completed in 1940.

Roll of Honor, No. XXII, dated July 31, 1869, submitted to Quartermaster General's Office, U.S.A., Washington, D.C., recorded the graves of 16,485 Union soldiers interred in the national cemetery at Nashville, Tennessee and remains as a part of the cemetery's historical records.

Originally there were 16,489 interments (burials) of known soldiers and employees: 38 were officers, 10,300 were white soldiers, 1,447 were colored soldiers, and 703 were employees.

Among the unknown, there were 3,098 white soldiers, 463 colored soldiers and 29 employees. The deceased had been gathered from an extensive region of Middle Tennessee and southern Kentucky. The number of distinct burial places from which these bodies were taken is 251.

A very large proportion of the dead in the cemetery, however, were transferred from the hospital burial grounds in and around the city of Nashville and from temporary burial grounds around general hospitals in Nashville and nearby battlefields of Franklin and Gallatin, Tenn. Reinterments were also made from Bowling Green and Cave City, Ky.

During the Civil War, if marked at all, wooden headboards with the names and identifying data painted thereon marked graves of those who died in general hospitals, on the battlefields, or as prisoners of war. Many of these headboards deteriorated through exposure to the elements. The result was that when the remains were later removed for burial to a national cemetery, identifications could not be established, and the gravesites were marked as unknown.

Minerva Evaline “Nevie” McCaleb was born January 6, 1841, Jackson Co., TN, **daughter of Capt. Samuel Vanransalear Asiel Silo Moore McCaleb and Ellenor “Nellie” Rhea Ray. Minerva married Willie “Wiley” B. Gentry** about 1858, a Union soldier in the Civil War. He was killed at the Battle of Murfreesboro, TN. Nervie said they could hear the roaring of cannons as the battle was going on and they knew that some of the family was fighting in that battle. Some time during the battle, which lasted from December 31, 1862 through January 2, 1863, Wiley was buried in the Nashville National Cemetery, 1420 Gallatin Road South, Madison, TN – Section B, grave 6458. Wiley was the son of Robert Gentry & Nancy Harris.

Later Minerva married Thomas Stone. They divorced before 1880. She reared her children by herself, mostly, and saw that each one of them received a good education. She appears to be holding a Bible in her hand in the picture above. This tells us where she got the strength to become the strong woman that she was. Her home was on a farm now owned by Roy Bailey on Cane Creek Road in Putnam Co., TN. She died May 19, 1927 and is buried in West Cemetery, Putnam Co., TN. She was the mother of seven children.

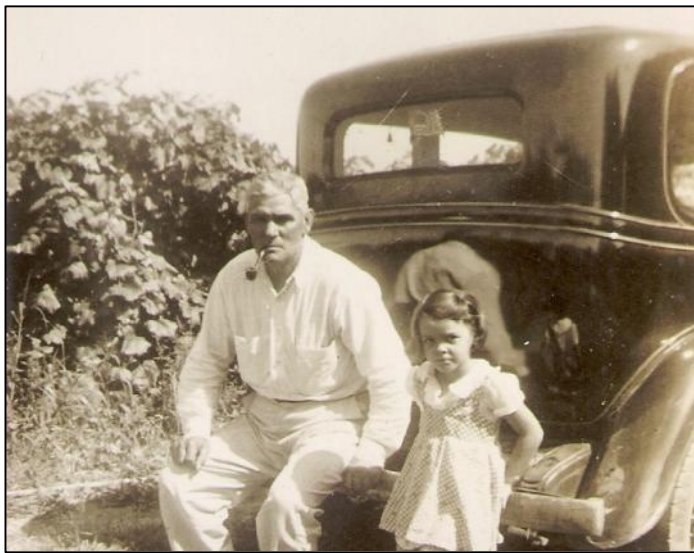

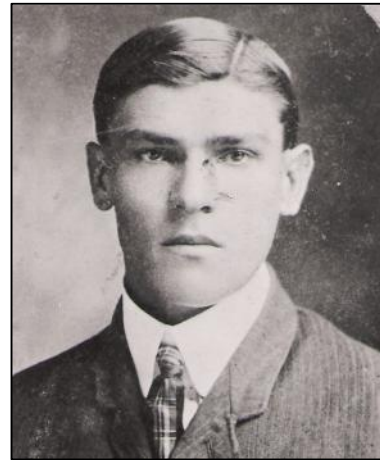
