"In Congress, the Indians had an eloquent champion the angular, aristocratic, Senator from New Jersey. Theodore Frelinghuysen.... For six hours he took the Senate floor in a defense of the Cherokees which was reprinted in every newspaper in the land and made him famous."

This child, possibly a grandchild of Joel and Mary, was obviously named for the champion of the Cherokee cause, which adds credence to the family story that Mary was a Cherokee Indian
