

Herion to prove his age when he drew his SS or something like that. In looking at it I see that a story that most of us have is wrong. I was always told that they were married in Paralee's Uncle Robert Gentry's yard, but this says they were married in Aden's. It also lists the children. Bessie Lee Herion is the daughter of William Robert Herion Sr. (my grandfather) and his first wife Allie Duncan. Bessie was raised by Paralee and Timothy after her mother died at her birth.
