Capel Hendley is buried in Thomas Cemetery on Waterplant Rd. in Baxter, TN. Ammon and Teddie are buried in Henley Cemetery on Henley Rd. in Baxter, Tennessee. Joel Hendley was once a minister in Jackson County, Tennessee. Joel's wife was Mary Horne and its believed she was if not 1/2 full blooded Cherokee Indian. Joel Hendley was Irish descent.

When you study your heritage you have to realize Georgia and North Carolina wasn't the same as today. America was only 13 colonies and at one time Tennessee was considered North Carolina. Also Putnam County, Tennessee was once Jackson County, Tennessee.
