"The area we focused on was the officer who showed the most improvement," said Capt. Bryant Swallows.

Chief Dale Armour added that initiative was another factor in the decision.

"We looked at the officer who showed the most initiative," Armour said. "He saw projects to completion, even if that meant he had to come in on his own time to do it."

One project for Officer Bilbrey included setting up the department's command post, which is used in special city events, like the Algood Christmas parade and 4th of July firework show.

"He's taken the bull by the horns, and set up all the technology for it," Capt. Swallows said.

Bilbrey grew up knowing he wanted to be in law enforcement. He began his career as a dispatcher for the Tennessee Highway Patrol, and worked there for eight years.

"So I went and graduated from the Tennessee Law Enforcement Training Academy," Bilbrey said. "Now I've been working here at the Algood Police Department for two and a half years."
