No. 19: Surveyor Entries: Putnam Co., TN

William Baker Enters fifty acres of land in Putnam County on the waters of the Falling Water Beginning at a stake the South West corner of **Isaac A. Huddleston** fifty acre tract conveyed to him by David Huddleston the 17th day of October 1850. Running thence North with the west boundary line of said tract eighty five poles to a Poplar & black oak the North West corner of said tract. Thence East with the North boundary line of said tract to a stake in the west boundary line it being the South west corner of a tract of land conveyed to **Charles Huddleston** by **James P. Thompson**. Administrator of **Thomas Hopkin's** deceased. Thence North with the west boundary line of said tract to a stake & two dogwood pointers it being the South West corner of Jordon F. Huddleston Sixty two acre tract conveyed to him by Charles Huddleston. Thence West to a stake in the East boundary line of a one hundred acre tract conveyed to **Isaac A. Huddleston** by **David Huddleston** October 1850. Thence South with the East boundary line of said tract to a Hickory the beginning corner of said tract. Thence South forty five degrees west with said line Twenty eight poles to a dogwood a corner of said tract. Thence with John L. Huddleston's line to the beginning.

Thomas Anderson Jr. Enters fifty acres of land in Putnam County on the waters of Wolf Creek. Beginning on a Sugar tree the North East corner of a twenty five acre tract made in the name of **Reuben Alexander**, Running thence North to Claiborne Vaughn's line. Thence North to **Claiborne Vaughn's** line. Thence West with his line. Thence South to **Reuben Alexander's** one hundred acre Entry. Thence East to the Beginning. This 15th day of November 1855.

John Davis Enters one hundred acres of land in Putnam County on the head waters of Martin's Creek. Beginning on a Poplar the South West corner of ? Brown's Three hundred acre tract. Running Thence North to Carter Whitefields line. Thence West to **Hiram Brown's** East boundary line. Thence South with said line to **Quinton Lowe's** line. Thence East to the Beginning.

Silas W. Gentry and Elijah S. Ellis enters four hundred acres of land in Putnam County on the waters of Cane Creek Beginning on the North West corner of a fifty acre tract belonging to the heirs of **Samuel Ray**. Running thence West Thence South Thence East Thence North to the Beginning including and excluding all older valid claims.

M.F. Jones Enters One hundred and fifty acres of land in Putnam County on the waters of Mine Lick Creek Beginning on **Henderson Tilley's** North West corner. Running thence west with **John Bullington's** North boundary line to **A.T. Mott's** East boundary line. Thence North with the same to said Jones' South West corner. Thence East & round with old line to **James Allison's** North West corner.

Thence South to the Beginning including all vacant land and excluding all older valid claims. This 23rd day of February 1857.

Meredith J. Gentry & Gordon C. Maxwell Enters one thousand acres of land in Putnam County, and on the waters of Wolf Creek and on the East side of the Caney Fork of Cumberland River. Beginning on a dogwood & beech, the dogwood being the South East corner of an Entry made by **Charles Smith** on the top of the Ridge between the long branch & Sugar tree Hollow. Running East and West from the beginning and South for Complement including and excluding all older valid claims.

V.W. Anderson Enters fifty acres of land in Putnam County on the waters of Caney fork Beginning on a chestnut Oak in the North boundary line of **G.C. Maxwell's** one hundred acre tract. Running thence North to **Thomas Scutter's** line. Thence East with his line to **Edward Anderson's** line. Thence South with said Anderson's west boundary line to Maxwell's line. Thence West with Maxwell's line to the Beginning.

Beginning on a maple standing where **Robert Smith's** line of his 91 acre tract crosses the line of said Maxwell's 100 acre tract Running North to Scutter's line Thence East with said line to **Anderson's** line of his 50 acre tract. Thence South with his line to his corner Thence West to the Beginning excluding all older valid claims.

This 25th day of September 1857.

Bird S. Jones & John/James R. Jones Enters one hundred acres of land in Putnam County on the waters of the Buffalow Valley of Indian Creek of the Caney fork. Beginning on a Buckeye & Sugar tree pointer the North West Corner of Claiborne Vaughn's farm 25 acre tract standing in the line of a 150 acre tract in the name of **Edward Anderson.**

West with said line to **Patsey Smith's** line of her 25 acre tract. South with her line to a line of an other tract of **Claiborne Vaughn's**. Thence East with said line to the West boundary line of the first named 25 acre tract North with the same to the Beginning including the improvement of **John R. Jones**.
