



Bank of Buffalo Valley, Tennessee. State Senator Jim Evans was president. The bank closed during the 1930's. It has been the U.S. Post Office since about 1960.



Dr. Farmer Spring (Town Spring), near Buffalo Valley. Many residents got their water from this spring. Jesse James would get water from this spring when hidden out in this area, while the Younger Brothers visited kinfolks near Chestnut Mound, Tennessee in the late 1800's.

Located in Buffalo Valley, this old building has housed a number of businesses including the DuBois Brothers General Store and Funeral Parlor in the early 1900's. In the 1920's it was the Walter R. Shanks General Merchandise Store. In the early 1930's it was home to Pete Gill Merchandise, and from the late 1930's until the 1960's, it was T.D. Alcorn General Merchandise. It also housed the Buffalo Valley Post Office in the 1940's and 1950's.



The Peter's Cave near Buffalo Valley on Little Indian Creek and Young Hollow and on the old Bartlett Farm. The cave was used to get salt peter to make gun powder during the Civil War.
