

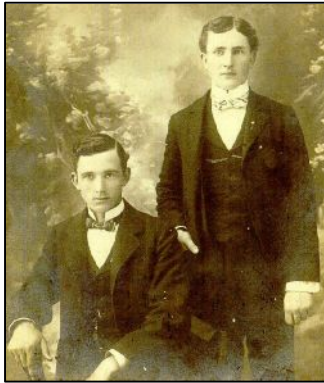
Oakley – Ensor Wedding
