COOKEVILLE — A memorial service for Mrs. Chongsuk Swong, 90, of Cookeville, will be held Saturday, Feb. 25, at 3 p.m. at the Cookeville chapel of Hooper-Huddleston & Horner Funeral Home. Celebrant Judy Duke will officiate. Her family will receive friends Saturday from 2 p.m. until service time at the funeral home.

She died Wednesday, Feb. 22, 2017, at NHC Healthcare of Cookeville.

Chongsuk was born March 28, 1926, in Seoul, Korea. Raised by her grandfather following the death of her father, she studied in Korea during her elementary school years. Displaying her adventurous spirit, she moved, alone, to Japan during her middle school years to study high school level courses. Returning to Korea, she earned a degree and was a 1948 graduate of the prestigious Ewha University for Women in Korea.



In 1966, her husband, Dr. Khyson Swong, accepted a position as a professor in the math department at Tennessee Tech University. A devoted wife, mother and homemaker through her life, she and Khyson founded a Karate uniform manufacturing company, Sarang Manufacturing, that operated in Cookeville for 15 years.

She is survived by her husband of 62 years, Dr. Khyson Swong; sons, Dr. Chin Whan (Soo Jung) Swong of Ottawa, Ill., Chin Hoe (Dr. Inkyun Yook) of Alpine, N.J., and Chin Goo (Sammy) Swong of Los Angeles, Calif.; daughter, Nancy Swong of Fort Lee, N.J.; grandchildren, Dr. Kevin (Seo-Hyun Kim) Swong, Dr. Michael Swong, Sarah Swong and Gregory Swong; and great-grandchild, Elliot Swong.
