
Sam Howard Greenwood Obt.

Mr. Greenwood was the CEO and founder of Eagle Furniture in 1968, and was the owner of the Cookeville Motel from 1959 until 1979.

Sam was a veteran of World War II, serving in the 159th Combat Engineering Company that landed at Omaha Beach under General Patton's 3rd Army. Mr. Greenwood's family were one of the founders of Paran United Methodist Church.

His family includes a son and daughter-in-law, Sam D. and Judy Greenwood of Cookeville; grandchildren and spouses, Sam G. and Gina Greenwood and Angie and David Stamps, all of Cookeville; five great-grandchildren, Amber, Samantha and Sam J. Greenwood and Jacob and Austin Stamps; a cousin, William Clark of Florida; and a special friend, Marie Spivey.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Geraldine Wells Greenwood; an infant daughter, Darlene Greenwood; two brothers and a sister-in-law, Doyle and Vergie Mae Greenwood and Calvin Greenwood; and a sister and brother-in-law, Mildred Greenwood and Morris Jarvis.
