- S. Houston Proffitt, 81, native of Putnam County and well known East Tennessee school man and religious leader, died November 26, at his home in Chattanooga. Funeral services were held in Chattanooga on Thursday morning at the Central Church of Christ.

Mr. Proffitt was the son of the late James and Lucinda Proffitt, members of pioneer Putnam County families. He was married to the former Miss Neveda Williams, and the couple celebrated their golden wedding anniversary in October.

Known as "professor" throughout the South and Southwest, Mr. Proffitt was principal of a number of high and elementary schools. He became a member of the Church of Christ in 1893, and has preached in a number of churches in the Chattanooga area in addition to doing evangelistic work in Texas, Oklahoma, Georgia, Alabama, Missouri, and Florida.

In addition to his widow, survivors include a daughter, Mrs. Harry Leon Brown, Chattanooga; brother, R.E.L. Proffitt, Cookeville, and three grandchildren.
