The death of William H. Buck, age 71 years, at his home on the Buck Mountain road two miles east of Cookeville, on Tuesday evening at 6 o'clock, marks the passing of a well known and esteemed citizen belonging to one of the pioneer families of Putnam county. He was a quiet, unassuming man, attentive to his won business, and one who stood for the right as he saw it. He had been a faithful and consistent member of the Methodist church for many years and will be missed in his community.

While a young man he was married to Miss Tennessee Bullington, who with the following children survive him: four sons, Clay, Rush, Whitley, and Willis, and five daughters, Emily, Mrs. Sophia Shipley, Mrs. Beulah Bohannon, Mrs. Frances King of McEwen and Mrs. May Mitchell of Tyron, OK.

The funeral was held at the residence Wednesday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, at 1 p.m. by Rev. Dow A. Ensor, with the following pall bearers: John Lee, Milton Ford, Bub Nichols, Clay Huddleston, Bill Hall, B. C. Huddleston, Will McCormick and Ridley Buck, followed by burial at the Salem graveyard.

Mr. Carver, of the Jere Whitson Hardware Company had charge of the interment.
