Pg. 321 - Miranda Josephine "Josie" (Winfrey/Winfree) Starnes was living in Putnam Co., TN when she died. Josie was born on November 18, 1874 in Cove Hollow, DeKalb County. She was the daughter of



Henry Lucas and Nancy Jane Holland Winfrey. Her paternal grandparents were Benjamin Franklin "Frank" Winfrey and Judith Robinson. Josie's father Henry was the fourth child of his parents, and was born on March 6, 1843 in DeKalb Co., TN. He was married to Nancy Jane on August 23, 1865 in Franklin County, Illinois, by John Miller, J. P. Henry went there during the Civil War.

After Josie's parents returned from Illinois they had seven children, of which she was the second child. Her siblings were: William Henry, Sidney Brooks, Mary, James Edgar, John Franklin, and Robert Lee. Josie's only sister Mary died as a child.

Josie was wed to Robert Emmett Starnes, a Methodist minister of the Methodist Episcopal Church (Northern branch). The couple lived in Putnam County. They had at least six children before they separated. These were: Solon, Laura, Eunice, Agnes, Fannie Mai, and Doyle. Josie died on January 12, 1935 at Baxter, Putnam County, Tennessee. She was sixty-one years old. The family buried her at the Odd Fellows Cemetery.
