

WILL OF J. D. EVANS

I, J. D. Evans, of Buffalo Valley County of Putnam, Tenn being of sound mind and desirous of directing the disposition of my estate after my death do make this my last will.

First – I direct that all burial expences be pade. Next all just debts – next I leave to Sion Evans the sum of twenty-five dollars.

To Jesse J. Evans five dollars. To Tennessee Laurence with of Gummer Laurence twenty-five dollars. Marinda McMillan Five dollars. William Thomas Evans ten dollars.

The balance to be distributed equally between L. F. Evans, I. W. Evans and Palina Pammero's heirs and Licitty Winchester wife of J. P. Winchester and her heirs. I appoint I. W. Evans as executor of this will that he be allowed the sum of Seventy-five dollars for his Services as executor.
