Funeral Services Held Saturday for Ethel Jared
Herald – Citizen Newspaper, Cookeville, TN
21 September 1944

Funeral services for Ethel Jared, 55, of Lufkin, TX, were held in Cookeville, Saturday afternoon at the Whitson Funeral Home, with the Rev. J.A. Harris officiating.

Mr. Jared's death occurred at a Waco, TX, hospital, where he had been for only a short time, however, he had been suffering from a heart ailment for several months.

The son of Simon and Lucy A. Denny Jared, who died when he was a small boy, he was reared by his uncle and aunt, Mr. and Mrs. John Bell Denny, of Buffalo Valley, and was educated in the Cookeville City schools, and during that time made his home with his cousins, Mrs. O.K. Holladay and the late Judge Holladay. He served with the U.S. Marines during World War I and since that time had been with the Forest Rangers, located for many years in NC and East TN, and later to Lufkin.

His wife, the former Miss Ruth Meachum, of Jackson, MS, survives and other survivors are a son, Capt. George Jared, of Camp Campbell, KY, and an aunt, Mrs. John Bell Denny and many other relatives throughout Putnam County, TN.

Burial was in the Cookeville City Cemetery, Cookeville, TN.
