BUFFALO VALLEY MAN DIES IN CRASH

An elderly Buffalo Valley, TN man was killed Friday morning and his next door neighbors injured in a truck collision on Highway 70 West in a head-on crash, according to Trooper Robert Marlowe.

Dead on arrival at Cookeville General Hospital was Houston Campbell Jared, 78, of Route 1, Buffalo Valley. Injured were Harwood H. Huddleston, 77, also of Route 1, Buffalo Valley, and his wife, Beulah H. Huddleston, 71.

Jared and the Huddlestons were next-door neighbors.

Jared was driving his 1983 Ford pickup truck west on Highway 70 five miles west of Baxter when Huddleston's 1978 Chevrolet pickup, headed east, crossed the center line and hit the Jared vehicle head on, Tennessee Highway Patrol officials said.

Mr. & Mrs. Huddleston were taken to Cookeville General Hospital for treatment, and Mr. Huddleston was released by mid-afternoon, Friday.

Cause of the accident is unknown, State Trooper Robert Marlowe said.

Rescue Squad workers had to remove the top of Jared's truck to remove his body. Huddleston was reportedly treated and released from Cookeville General Hospital, while his wife was admitted for observation.

The accident occurred at 10:15 a.m., Friday.

Funeral services for Houston Campbell Jared will be held at Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church today, Sunday, April 22, at 3 p.m. with the Rev. Joe Elledge and Rev. Ernest Cashdollar officiating.

The body is at the Baxter Chapel of Hooper & Huddleston Funeral Home.

Burial will be in the Jared family cemetery in Buffalo Valley.

A native of Putnam County, he was the son of the late Joseph Haywood and Ina B. McCaleb Jared.

He was a member of the Pleasant Grove Methodist Church at Gentry. He was a farmer.

His family includes his wife, Mrs. Ruby Maddux Jared; two sons, Joe Houston Jared of Buffalo Valley and David Jared of North Little Rock, Arkansas; eight grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Active pallbearers are Clarence Taylor Huddleston; Robert Hughes; Kenneth Pullum; Tony Stout; John T. Jared, and Wilbur Hughes.

The Baxter Chapel of Hooper & Huddleston Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.
