Charming Bride-To-Be Of September

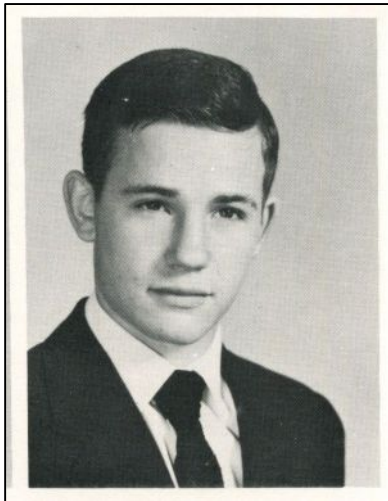

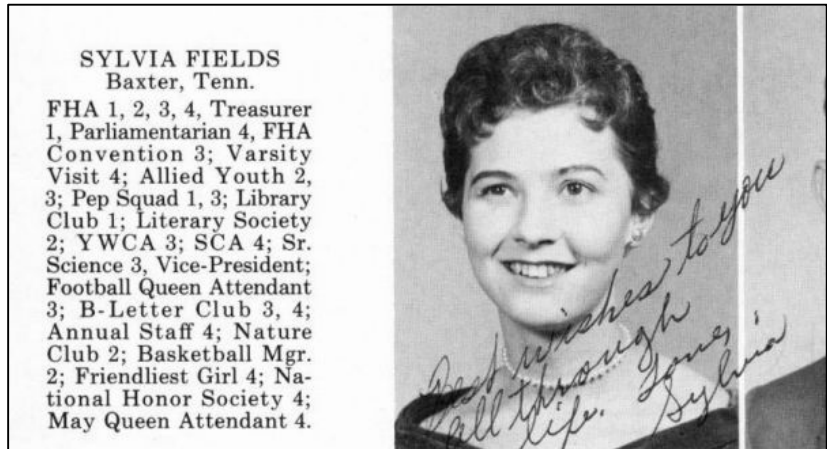
