Dr. A. D. Byrne Dies Suddenly December 24:

Gainesboro was suddenly cast into a gloom of sorrow on December 24th, when it was learned that Dr. A. D. Byrne, dentist, has passed away at his home here.

Dr. Byrne had been in failing health for many months, but on the morning of his death he seemed as well as usual and in the morning drove to his farm near Granville. On his return he learned of the illness of his father at Cookeville. After he had lunch he started to see his father. Near the County line he had a puncture and secured some men to fix it. It was while the tire was being repaired that he complained of being ill. One of the men got in the car and drove him home. He lived only a few minutes after arriving at home.

Arthur Dillard, son of W. J. and Anne Carter Byrne, was born June 4, 1889 near Granville. He was educated in the schools at Granville and Cookeville. He received the D. D. S. degree from Vanderbilt University in 1914. In 1915 he came to Gainesboro and began the practice of his profession.

On December 21, 1916 he was married to Miss Esther Neely, of Granville. To them was born three children.

Dr. Byrne was well known in this and surrounding counties through his profession. His kind, ever-ready to help disposition endeared he to all who knew him. An outstanding man in his profession, his work was sought by many who came from a distance.

He professed faith in Christ at an early age and united with the Methodist Church at Cookeville. He was also a Mason and member of the Eastern Star.

He is survived by his wife and three children: Arthur Byrne, Jr. Ann Byrne and Betsy Byrne of Gainesboro; his father, W. J. Byrne, Cookeville; two brothers Dr. L. H. Byrne, Deming, NM; and Charles Byrne, Brawley, CA. Besides these many other relatives and friends.

Funeral services were conducted at the Methodist Church Friday morning, December 26, by Rev. O. P. Gentry of Manchester, assisted by the pastor Rev. L. F. Haley. The song service was in charge of a quartet composed of Mr. and Mrs. Jeff well and Mr. and Mrs. Donald Wall of Cookeville. Burial was in the City Cemetery at Cookeville.

The high esteem in which Dr. Byrne was held was evidenced by the beautiful flowers.
