Services for Mrs. Neta Jared Buck, 89, will be at 3 p.m. Friday at Lawrence-Sorensen Funeral Home with the Revs. James Westbrook and Dana Kuhn officiating. Burial will be in Maple Springs Cemetery in Henderson County.

Mrs. Buck, widow of Locie H. Buck, died this morning at Jackson-Madison County General Hospital after a long illness.

She was born in Texas, moved to the Maple-Springs community as a child, attended public schools in Madison County and had made her home in Jackson since 1944.

Mrs. Buck was a former member of Maple Springs Cumberland Presbyterian Church, where she taught a Sunday School class and was pianist for 27 years.

She later joined First Cumberland Presbyterian Church in Jackson, where she belonged to the Altruist Sunday School Class, the Cumberland Presbyterian Women and Circle No. 1.

Surviving are a son, Horace Buck of Jackson; two daughters, Mrs. Leon Harris and Mrs. Charles Giles, both of Jackson; a brother, W. F. Jared of Lancaster, CA; eight grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

Pallbearers will be Joe Overton, Norman Henry, Eugene Daniel, John Parnell, Charles Garrett, the Rev. Ralph Matlock, Wilburn Yates and Fred Michie Jr.

#8705 Bonita "Nita" Jared, b. 22 September 1894, to Franklin Petway and Susan Alice (Dodson) Jared, at Lockhart, Texas. She married 26 December 1916 at Beech Bluff, near Jackson, TN, Locie Hester Buck. He was b. 10 December 1899 at Beech Bluff. He died 29 January 1971.

Loice and Neta Buck were prominent land owners in the Maple Spring, Henderson Co. community, near Beech Bluff, TN. They were active in the Presbyterian Church where Locie served as Elder and Sunday School Supt. For twenty-seven years. During World War II Locie worked in the Milan Arsenal making ammunition.

In April 1944 Locie and Neta rented their farm out and moved to Gradena, CA to work as a butcher in the Supermarket of Neta's brother, Albert Jared. Their son, Horace, was in the service and Alviene was in Junior High School, and did not wish to go. They took only young Sylvia with them. After six months they moved to their farm home in Tennessee. In October 1944 they sold the farm and moved to Jackson for their retirement years.

In Jackson they became well known in the Church and Community. Locie served as Elder till his death. He sang in the Church Choir and was a member of the Original Fowler Quartet known throughout West Tennessee. He worked for Union University for many years in carpentry.

In the same Church Group, of course, Neta was also active. She played the piano for different events, was secretary of the Women's Missionary Circle and the Alturist Sunday School Class. When her health failed after two heart attacks and a bad fall, she sold her home and moved to Maplewood Health Care Center, where she lives. (March 1983).

Neta recalls her parents, Petway and Alice, moving from Texas when she was small, to Bloomington Springs, middle Tennessee. Petway bought a farm and worked it as long as his health permitted. He and Alice are buried in the Maple Springs Cemetery.
