

BRYAN S. JARED OBT.

Daily Ardmoreite, Ardmore, Oklahoma

Funeral services for Bryan S. Jared, Rusk, Texas, 56, were Wednesday at Wallace Funeral Home, Rusk, with the Rev. Jewel McClure officiating. Burial was in Rose Hill Cemetery here Thursday, Dr. Edwin W. Parker of First Methodist Church officiating at graveside rites. Harney Funeral Home directed burial.

Bearers were Joe Gill, Charles Lowrey, Jim McGoodwin, D. W. Hill, Dan Flannigan and Jack Williamson.

Jared was born in Whitehouse, Texas, and had made his home in Ardmore 18 years prior to moving to Rusk two years ago. He had once been manager of the Ardore Hotel.

At Rusk he owned and operated Jared's Restaurant. He was a veteran of World War II and a member of the Methodist Church.

Jared died in a Rusk hospital Tuesday following a heart attack. A columnist for the Rusk Cherokeean commented: "He was one of the finest men we've ever known. He was 'loaded' with humor...Rusk is a better town because he came our way."

Survivors include the widow, Margaret; a son, Scott; a daughter, Frances; and a brother, J. P., all of Rusk, and two sisters, Mrs. Don Jenkins, Little Rock, Ark., and Mrs. J. T. Moseley, Lafayette, La.

Funeral services will be held at nine o'clock Friday morning at the First Methodist Church of Rusk for S. H. Jared, 69, who died suddenly shortly after noon Wednesday at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Don Jenkins, of Rusk.
