C. Y. JARED, FORMER COOKEVILLIAN, DIES:

C. Y. Jared, 68, died Monday at his home on the Old Hickory Boulevard, in Davidson county. His death was due to heart trouble. He was a son of the late Rev. Wade Jared, a prominent Methodist minister. In his young manhood, he taught school for several years, and was for some time, principal of the Cookeville City school. After leaving Cookeville, he located in Seattle, WA, and for more than twenty years he was City Inspector of Weights and Measures of the City of Seattle. For the past years he has been living in Davidson county.

Mr. Jared is survived by his wife, Mrs. Jennie W. Jared, three sons, Dr. Myron S. (Shelby) Jared and Aubrey L. (Lucian) Jared of Seattle, WA, and E. O. Jared of Davidson county; and two daughters, Mrs. Miriam J. Bader of Got, CA, and Mrs. Lurlene DuBois of Madison, fifty grandchildren and his aged mother, Mrs. Alice Jared and his sister, Mrs. Vida DuBois, both of the eleventh district of this county, and by many other relatives in this county.

He was a member of the Methodist church and of the Masonic Order.

Funeral services will be conducted Friday afternoon at the Methodist church in Goodlettsville. Burial will take place in Spivey Hill cemetery near Nashville.

Mrs. Alice Adams Jared Dies At Home of Her Daughter:

Mrs. Alice Jared, age 93, one of the oldest best known and most highly esteemed women of this country, died Sunday morning at the home of her daughter and son-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. E. M. DuBois, on Peachtree Street.

Mrs. Jared was the widow of the late Rev. William Wade Jared, a well known Methodist minister who served pastorates in Tennessee, Missouri, and Kansas conferences. His death occurred about 45 years ago.

Mrs. Jared was born and reared in Macon County. She had resided in Putnam County since the death of her husband.

She had been a devoted member of the Methodist Church since her girlhood.

She is survived by her daughter, Mrs. Veda Jared DuBois, and by several grandchildren and great-grandchildren. A son, Prof. C. Y. Jared of Madison, died a few years ago.

Funeral services were conducted Monday afternoon in the Chapel of the Whitson Funeral Home by the Rev. D. A. Ensor. **Burial was in the City Cemetery.**
