Mr. Jared died Saturday, August 4, 2018 at his home.

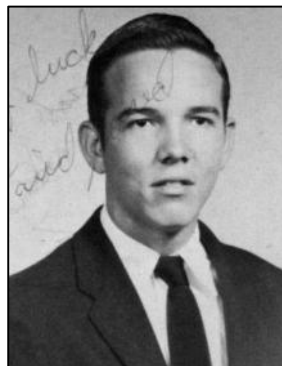


He was born Friday October 29, 1941 in Buffalo Valley to the late Houston and Ruby Maddux Jared.
