Mrs. Fannie Jared Dead

Mrs. Fannie Jared died Monday at her home near Pleasant Grove. She was about 70 yrs. old and her entire life had been spent in this county. She is survived by several grown children and by many other relatives in this county.

She was a sister of T. C. Holladay (*Thomas Calvin Holladay*) of this city and had many other relatives in Cookeville. She had been a member of the Methodist Church from girlhood and was a splendid Christian lady. Her remains were lowered Tuesday afternoon in the family cemetery near Pleasant Grove.
