

HASKER MICHAEL JARED OBT.

Herald, Cookeville, TN: 1 May 1919

H. M. Jared: This community was greatly shocked Tuesday, to hear of the sudden death in Nashville, Monday night, of **Haskell M. Jared**, proprietor of the Jared House on Fourth Avenue.

He was reared and married in this city, and his **mother, Mrs. Ellen Jared**, resides in this city.

His remains were interred at the Cookeville cemetery Wednesday afternoon. He was about 40 years old, and had many relatives and friends in this county. He is survived by his mother, wife and children **Ellen Frances** and **Henrietta Jared**. The deceased was a man of robust appearance, and his friends supposed him to be in the enjoyment of perfect health. He had been engaged in the hotel business in Nashville for several years prior to which he was a conductor on the T. C. R. R. and at the time of his death was treasurer of the Nashville Union Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen.
