Relatives have received a message announcing the death of Joe S. Jared at his home in Ada, OK, Tuesday afternoon after having suffered a stroke earlier in the day.

He was born and reared near Hopewell in the 11<sup>th</sup> Civil District of Putnam County, the son of the late W. E. Jared and Mrs. Mary B. Jared. He had resided in Ada many years where he had been active in business until the time of his death. He was 56 years of age, was a 32<sup>nd</sup> degree Mason, and had served as Supt. Of the First Methodist Church Sunday School in Ada. He has a son who is a minister in the Methodist Churchy.

Mr. Jared is survived by his wife, Mrs. Mabel Noe Jared, and 9 children all of OK. His aged mother also survives, as well as 3 sisters, Mrs. L. B. Thompson, OK, Mrs. R. H.
