William James Jared died at his home in this city last Sunday, surrounded by all of his immediate family and several friends. He was born June 27, 1840, and died April 27, 1919 being 78 years and 10 months of age.

At the age of 26 years he was converted and joined the Methodist church, of which he remained a most faithful member until his death. He was a gallant Confederate soldier and was wounded in a battle in Mississippi. He was married more than fifty years ago, and is survived by his wife, Mrs. Elizabeth Jared and six children as follow: Mrs. S. A. Ditty, Murfreesboro; Mrs. Susie Foster, of this city; Frank Jared of Baxter, Tenn.; Mrs. Vallie McDonald, of Chestnut Mound, Tenn, R. 1; and Beersh Jared of this city. Funeral services were held at the Methodist church Monday afternoon and the remains were laid to rest in the city cemetery.

Mr. Jared was a good man – kind, patient, honest, and respected by all.
