***#1 William Jared** – born 3 June 1758, *Bible*, Loudoun Co. Virginia, son of John Jared the wagonmaker and Hannah Whitacre; died 22 September 1827, Putnam Co., TN; md 2/6 December 1792, Jefferson Co., TN **Anne Elizabeth Raulston** born 6 January 1770, *Bible*, Bedford, VA, daughter to Matthew Raulsten and Martha “Polly” Moore. She died 18 June 1835, *Bible*, Big Indian Creek, Putnam Co., TN.

He married Elizabeth Raulston, the 22 year old daughter of Matthew Raulston of Bedford, Co., VA. William was 34 years old. To begin the exodus of the Jared family from Virginia, though the Cumberland Gap into Kentucky, Illinois, and Tennessee, William and Elizabeth (Raulston) Jared moved from Bedford Co., VA with their two oldest children, little Moses and baby Patsy, to a tract of land patented to him for his Revolutionary War Service in the year 1796. Their third child, Naoma (Simmons) and the six children following her were born in what is now Putnam Co., TN.

He located on Indian Creek, about 2 miles east of Buffalo Valley, Putnam Co., TN. He received a United States land grant of almost one thousand acres. William’s land was later owned by John Bell Denny and Mrs. Alice A. Jared. Robert A. William was a prosperous worker in wood, making wagons, wagon wheels, spinning wheels, looms and such other implements useful to the pioneers of those days. William married Elizabeth Raulsten, the sister of Colonel James Raulsten of the 2nd Division of the Tennessee Militia, in the War of 1812. Colonel Raulston’s picture hangs in the State Capitol Building in Nashville, TN. The William Jared Bible is owned by Martha Ann Sanders of Buffalo Valley, TN. (Col. Raulston’s picture was not in the Capitol when I visited in 2001 – was told it could be in storage. Audrey J. Lambert.)

Practically every other civic organization in the county contributed to the war effort in one way or another. The Parent-Teacher Association featured speakers on various topics related to the war. The Cookeville Woman's Club made shirts and pajamas for wounded soldiers. To homes throughout the area Boy Scouts distributed propaganda, put out by the National Committee on Public Information and designed to win support for the fighting.

Temporary groups sprang up to accomplish specific tasks. Mrs. Rutledge Smith helped a Surgical Dressing Committee. A War Savings Committee urged Putnam Countaians to buy Liberty Bonds. In November of 1918 a local Committee for the United War Work Campaign put on a drive to raise seven thousand dollars for seven agencies, including the YMCA, the American Library Association and the Salvation Army. Oscar King Holladay, James N. Cox, and Charles D. Daniel of Cookeville; R.N. Browder of Monterey; and **W.W. Jared (Walter Wirt Jared)** of Buffalo Valley headed the men's committee for the drive. Mrs. Herbie J. Shanks, Mrs. George Haile, Mrs. Oscar K. Holladay, Mr. Walter R. Carlen, Miss Mable Hamilton, Mrs. A. J. Coile, Mrs. W.M. Shanks, Mrs. John A. Epperson, Mrs. Charles D. Daniel, and Miss Gretchen Boyd organized the women's effort.

Because only twenty percent of all farms in Putnam County operated by owners were mortgaged in 1930, and since local farmers had little cash for investment, most Putnam Countians did not suffer during the depression as did other occupational groups and farmers elsewhere. They had little cash, but they were accustomed to that, and they

produced much of what was necessary to live. **Walter Jared** of Buffalo Valley noted to Hugh Childress, as they sat down to a table loaded with fried chicken, country ham and gravy, vegetables for the garden, sweet milk and buttermilk, and apple pie, “Almost everything you see on this table was grown right on this farm.” Jokingly he added. “I guess I’m the best fed and the raggediest and poorest man in Putnam County!”

Boys' State Features Tennessee Supreme Court's Scales Program, Gov. Bredesen

COOKEVILLE, Tenn. (May 23, 2003) -- More than 630 Tennessee high school juniors will learn how the scales of justice balance during this year's American Legion Boys' State at Tennessee Tech University held May 25-May 31.

For the first time in its 39th year at Tennessee Tech, Boys' State will host the SCALES program, the Supreme Court Advancing Legal Education for Students, during which the Tennessee Supreme Court will hold a special session to hear oral arguments in two actual Supreme Court cases.

"The Tennessee Supreme Court believes that knowledge and understanding of the judicial branch of government are essential to good citizenship," Chief Justice Frank Drowota said. "The SCALES Project is designed to educate young participants about the system they will inherit."

Issues in the cases students will hear on Wednesday, May 28, include whether evidence — methamphetamine found in the door panels of a vehicle during a traffic stop — should be suppressed and whether a trial court can require a criminal defendant, as a condition of probation, to legally establish the father of her child. More than 11,000 Tennessee high school students have taken part in SCALES since the Supreme Court initiated it in 1995.

During the week, participants are immersed in learning state government by running a mock 51st state, Boys' State. They will organize political parties and establish city, county and state governments by election, complete with primaries and political campaigns.

"Boys' State promotes a respect for our government, our leaders and our military," said Marc Burnett, director and TTU's vice president of student affairs, who has worked with the program since 1984. "Four members of my family served in the armed forces, and I am honored to be able to contribute this service."

Boys' Staters will receive qualified instruction and advice during the week from elected state officials, including Tennessee Gov. Phil Bredesen, who will speak Saturday, May 31. Collin Bills, 2002 Boys' State governor, will address participants when they arrive Sunday. NASA astronaut Eric A. Boe will speak to delegates Monday, May 26. Judge Frank G. Clement Jr. of Nashville will preside over a special program on Wednesday. Teachers, administrators, and community leaders nominated this year's group based on their academic talent and their potential for leadership. When they arrive on campus, the young men are assigned a mythical city, county and political party.

Community leaders assisting with government instruction include John Keyes, Commissioner of Tennessee's Department of Veterans Affairs; Billy C. Rodgers, senior field advisor for county technical assistance service of the University of Tennessee; **former state representative Jerry Jared**; Mary Virginia Maddux, former House Index Clerk; Cookeville attorney Jeffrey Jones; and Stephanie Miller, Cookeville's city clerk and finance director.

The week is not all politics and speeches. Boys' Staters can show off their talents in athletic events, including a swim meet and an all-star basketball game. Others will take the stage for a talent show or perform with the Boys' State band.

At the end of the week, the young men's families can join them for a picnic on campus, and special guests can attend the Boys' State governor's inaugural ball. On Saturday, participants will gather for a final parade, band concert and inauguration ceremony for their new governor. Gov. Bredesen will speak during the ceremony.

American Legion Posts across the state sponsor delegates and fund the activities held at Tennessee Tech.
