

WILL OF JOHN JARED

Deceased

Tennessee Putnam County Wills, Vol 6, 1876-1933, pg. 108

(John Jared, b. 8 June 1811, Jackson Co., TN – d. 21 December 1896, Putnam Co., TN, md Eliza Ann Carr, b. 14 November 1812, Jackson Co., TN – d. 8 October 1900. John Jared, s/o William Jared (1758-1827) & Anne Elizabeth Roulston (1770-1835).

I John Jared of the County of Putnam and State of Tennessee being of Sound mind and deposing memory, do make and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void all others by me at any time made.

First: I direct that all my debts be paid as soon after my death as possible out of my monies I may be possessed or may first come into the hands of my Executors,

Second: I direct that set apart to my widow should she be surviving dower exemption homestead and years support as provided by law,

Third: I give and bequeath to my daughter Virginia Scudders the sum of four hundred dollars.

Fourth: I give and bequeath to my son C C Jared the sum of two hundred dollars,

Fifth: I give and bequeath to the heirs of my deceased son Josiah Jared the sum of four hundred dollars,

Sixth: I will and bequeath the remaining part of my property to my widow and at her death to be equally divided among my lawful heirs.

Seventh: It is my will and desire that none of this property or money I have given to any of my children either directly or indirectly be charged so them after my death as an advancement, but that my gifts be taken by them without any charge of advancement in the final division and distribution of my estate.

Eight: I hereby nominate and appoint my son C C Jared my executor Said executor will not be required to give bond and have the sum of fifty dollars for his service.

In witness where of I have this day set my hand and seal this the 16th day of February 1893.
