

WILL OF MOSES BRANSFORD JARED

(Moses Bransford Jared, b. 11 April 1834, TN – d. 4 July 1899, Putnam Co., TN, md Savella "Savilla" Hughes, b. 30 June 1836, TN – d. 10 November 1876, Putnam Co., TN. Moses Bransford Jared, s/o John Jared (1811-1896) & Eliza Ann Carr or Kerr (1812-1900).

I **M. B. Jared** do make and publish this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and making void all other wills by me at any time made.

First I direct that my funeral expenses, and all debts be paid as soon after my death as possible out of any moneys that I may die possessed of or may first come in the hands of my executor.

Secondly, I give and bequeath to my three children **Harvy Jared**, **Alice Jared** and **Lassie Jared**, all my property both real and personal, jointly to be divided amongst themselves after my death in such a manner as to them may seem proper. My real Estate consists of two tracts of land lying in Putnam County Tennessee; and in the 11th district of said county, on Indian Creek of Caney Fork. First tract containing by estimation fifty acres, and bounded as follows; Beginning at a Stake at the south bank of Indian Creek, running thence South 28 degrees East twelve one half poles to a stake thence South 54 degrees West fourteen poles to a stake. Thence South 33 degrees East about one-hundred and fifty poles to a Stake on a rige (*sic*) in **Medleys** North boundary line, Thence a western direction with **Medleys** and **Whiteheads** lines, about fifty five poles to **Denneys** East boundary line. Thence a north direction with said line to the creek. Thence and East direction with the South bank of the Creek to the beginning. Second tract lying in the County and State aforesaid, and bounded on the north by the lands of **L. L. Leftwich** on the East by the lands of **B. B. Nichols**; on the South by the lands of **Fate Boyd** and others, West by **J. P. Nichols**.

Thirdly, I require and make it obligatory on my three Children to wit; Harvey, Alice and Lassie Legates in the forgoing Will to take care of, cloth, feed and provided for my son William Jared who is mindably (*sic*) incapable of taking care of and providing for himself this last bequest is made in consideration of the bequests hereto made and is in ____ of any provisio9n made indep____ to said William Jared.

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint Harvey Jared my Executor to carry out the intentions of this my last Will and Testament in witness thereof, I do to this my Will set my hand This 11th day of July 1899.
