b. 5 December 1875, TN – d. 21 June 1921, Baxter, Putnam Co., TN, md Eugenia Hughes (1885-1944). William Allison Jared, s/o Moses "Mode" Eskew Jared (1844-1884) & Frances "Fannie" Holladay (1844-1884). Siblings of William Allison "W. A." Jared are: Magdalia "Maggie" Jared (1867-1887) md Hugh Bradley Maddux (1854-1929); Betty Gertrude Jared (1869-1875); Levergne "Verna" Jared; John Jared; Willie Jared; Thomas Bascom Jared (1878-1925; Samuel Scruggs Jared (1880-1935) md Cordlie Louvena "Vena" Leftwich (1886-1957) and Frances Jared. Eugenia (Hughes) (1885-1944) is buried in Hughes Cemetery, Putnam Co., TN.

Will of W.A. Jared deceased. I--- W.A. Jared of the town of Baxter, County of Putnam, State of Tennessee, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time made.

(WITNESSETH)

1st, I direct my executrix hereinafter named to pay my just debts and funeral expenses  
2nd All of my property, real, personal or mixed wheresoever situate, which I now own or may hereafter acquire and of which I shall die, seized or possessed of, I give devise and bequeath absolutely and in fee simple to my wife Eugenia Jared her heirs and assigns forever, except the <sup>home</sup> place where I am now living which was conveyed to W. A. Jared and wife Eugenia Jared by R. E. Jared and located on the Baxter & Ensor Pike in the 20th, Civil Dist. of Putnam County, Tenn in the town of Baxter Tennessee which I desire to be disposed of as follows; I desire that all my interest in and unto the above described property be retained by my <sup>said</sup> wife Eugenia Jared as <sup>home</sup> for her and her mother during the life time of said Eugenia Jared and at her death it is my desire that my interest in and unto the above described property be divided equally among my brothers John Jared, Bascom Jared and Scruggs Jared their heirs and assigns.  
3rd. I name constitute and appoint my wife Eugenia Jared Executrix of this my last will and testament and I request that she be not required to give bond for the faithful performance of her duties as such.  
Witness my hand this the 2nd day of June 1921 at Baxter, Tenn.
