Rev. Ed Malone and Brother James Trivette will officiate at the services.

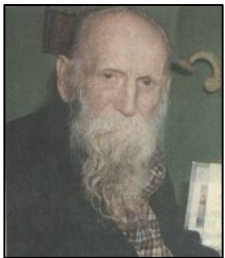
