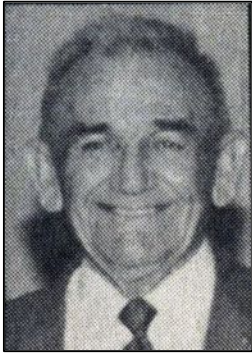


**William Charlie Jernigan Obt.**
