COOKEVILLE -- Funeral services for George G. Loftis, 88, of Cookeville, were held at 10 a.m. today, Tues., Jan. 2, from the Cookeville Chapel of Hooper & Huddleston Funeral Home. Burial was in Cookeville City Cemetery.
