Beal McCaskill Buried at Hennepin

Funeral rites for Beal McCaskill, 67, were held at the Baptist church in Hennepin last Thursday afternoon by the pastor, Rev. Jim House, assisted by Judson Cook. Burial was in the Hennepin cemetery.

Mr. McCaskill, who had resided near Hennepin for more than half a century, died in an Oklahoma City hospital Wednesday morning following a major operation. he had been ill about two years.

Funeral services were held Thursday, Sept. 19 at First Baptist church in Cyril for a former Hennepin resident, Mrs. Elizabeth Loftis McCaskill. She died Sept. 17 in an Oklahoma City nursing home at the age of 80.

The measles and whooping cough have been scattered here, and there will probably be a few more cases, but we are keeping them corralled as much as possible, but the Cup law is not being enforced as it should be. A law should be enforced or repealed.
