John Franklin "Jack" Dealy, died Monday night at St. Thomas Hospital in Nashville following a short illness. Dealy was a former city editor for The Daily Herald.

Funeral services will be conducted Wednesday at 2:30 p.m. at Oakes and Nichols Funeral Home. Burial will be in Polk Memorial Gardens.

A native of Chicago, IL, Dealy was the son of the late William A. and Myrtle Carey Dealy. On Feb. 14, 1946, he married the former Mary Katherine "Kivyt" Maddux, who survives.

Dealy moved to Nashville in 1934 where he graduated from West High School. In August 1942, he entered the Army-Air Corps as a pilot trainee and was commissioned to second lieutenant in October 1943. 
