He was the son of the late William H. and Mattie Gentry Maxwell and the husband of the late Mattie Lou Mitchell Maxwell.

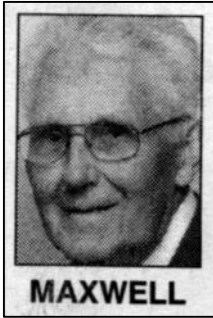
