LEBANON -- Funeral services for James Lindon (Jimmy) Maxwell, 84, of Lebanon, will be held Thursday, Dec. 3, at 10 a.m. at the Partlow Funeral Chapel in Lebanon. Burial will be in the Maxwell Family Cemetery in Baxter.

Mr. Maxwell died Monday, Nov. 30, 1998, at Mariner Health Care Center in Lebanon.
