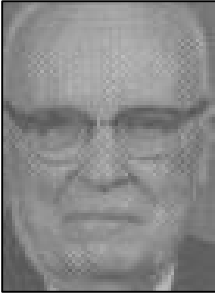


Paschal T. Maxwell Obt.



BAXTER -- Funeral services for Paschal Theo (P.T.) Maxwell, 100, will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday, July 8, from the Baxter Chapel of Hooper-Huddleston & Horner Funeral Home. Burial will be in Maxwell Cemetery North.
