For several years he taught school in the county and after completing his law course he was admitted to the Gainesboro Bar and practiced here several years.

He was **married to Miss Minnie Draper** on March 17, 1917 and went immediately to Purcell, OK, where he was admitted to the bar, and later served as County Attorney at that place.

In 1922 he returned to Gainesboro and resumed his practice of law.

Mr. Strode stood high in the councils of the Republican Party and had been US commissioner for several years. He had served as Mayor of Gainesboro and was Deacon in the Church of Christ at the time of his death.

The high esteem and confidence in which he was held was shown by the number of friends at the funeral and the number of floral offerings.

Dr. Edward W. Draper died at this home here Friday night November 17 following a heart attack.

He was a graduate of Jackson County Central High School and attended UT where he had his pre-med course, and graduated from the Medical School at Memphis. He served his internship at Presbyterian Hospital, Nashville.
