Herald - Citizen: April 15, 1940 – Rites held for Mrs. Sarah Elizabeth Slagle, 91. Last rites for Mrs. Sarah Elizabeth Slagle, 91 who died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Rob Davis, 3 miles south of Cookeville last Saturday, were held Sunday at Mrs. Davis' home, the Rev. B.A. Moore officiating. Burial was in the Choate Cemetery.

Mrs. Slagle was a member of the Methodist Church.

She is survived by 2 daughters, Mrs. Davis, and Mrs. John Clemmons of Nashville, TN; 2 sons, Cleve Slagle of Cookeville, TN and Harold Slagle of White County, TN.
