I also give to my daughter Margaret Russell seven pounds, also I give to my son James Paul's two children the land at the Catawba. I also give to the Covenanter Society in Winnsboro for the use of building a meeting house ten dollars. And I do constitute and appoint my son William Paul and John Paul executors to see that this my last will and testament be truly and faithfully fulfilled. According to the true intent and meaning of the author, given under my hand this third day of September, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Two.
