Notes: This book continues the work begun in North Carolina Taxpayers 1701-1786. It includes most of the remaining tax lists, from the earliest known to 1790, except for a few (most of which are redundant) which were recorded shortly before or after the tax lists in this and the first volume.

Most of the names included in this book were found in the microfilmed tax lists at the **North Carolina State Archives** in Raleigh (Roll S.50.10), or in photocopies of some records not on microfilm at NCSA, or in tax lists published in The North Carolinian, later titled the **Journal of North Carolina Genealogy**, and still later titled North Carolina Genealogy.

Names of taxpayers are given in alphabetical order for quick reference. The name of the county of residence of each taxpayer is provided as well as the date of the tax list. This volume includes the names of about 29,000 taxpayers.

Note: This work lists the names of the taxpayers resident in about half of the North Carolina counties formed before 1786. A second volume, it is hoped, will deal with the remaining counties. The object of this present volume is to set down in writing, while research is fresh, a list of those persons paying poll taxes or property taxes sometime between the years 1701 and 1786. For genealogical purposes, of course, the intent is to identify individuals in relation to a specific time and place, and to make public a class of records likely to assist in the advancement of research.

The majority of the names given here were copied from tax lists microfilmed at the North Carolina State Archives in Raleigh (roll numbers, 155.108 and 115.49). Supplementing this basic list, and integrated throughout the text, are names which have been extracted from The North Carolinian, afterwards called the Journal of North Carolina Genealogy and then simply North Carolina Genealogy, from which journal have also been taken names of person owning headrights and landrights.

For ease reference the names of taxpayers are given in a single alphabetical sequence. In all cases taxpayers are listed by county of residence and date, and in some cases additional data is supplied. The combined lists, with repeat entries for those people who appear in more than one tax list, contain approximately 28,000 names.

Introduction: Several criteria were used in selecting the deeds to be included in this book. The most important was to include all deeds proving or indicating relationships. Another was to select all deeds in which either the grantor or grantee, or both, lived in another county. This could indicate the counties from which people emigrated or to which they removed, many to other states. Also included are deeds in which both the grantor and grantee had the same surname. While this does not necessarily mean that they were related, it is a likely place to begin searching.

In many cases people sold land to their relatives in order to keep a tract from being divided. And there were many deeds of gift in which a normal price was stated. Since it was necessary to have a consideration named for the land or personal property, a high price would certainly make the gift seem more attractive.

Granville County has been found to be quite different from some other eastern North Carolina counties, namely, Edgecombe, Nash, and Halifax, in one respect. There were a very large number of merchants in Granville County from its beginning and they bought and resold quite a bit of the lands. They were noted, to a great extent, buying land at Sheriffs' sales and buying from persons who removed to other states. This also applied to the buying of slaves for resale. In the other counties mentioned, the merchants had very little to do with the buying and selling of land and personal property.

Another difference between Granville and the above named counties is that the boundaries of Granville County at that time were mostly artificial and many tracts of land lay in two counties and quite often in two states. Many persons who inherited part of a home tract found

that their part, when divided, lay in another county. So there were a great many of these "border line" sales and others by people living in a county which as actually only a few yards away.

All of the deeds in this book were abstracted by the late Zae Hargett Gwynn and the Tax List for 1769 was also copied and typed by her. This material would have filled at least three books of normal size. Therefore, it was thought best to select the deeds for inclusion in this book which seemed to give the most positive information for all genealogists. Joseph W. Watson




