Front Row: Wife of Horace Sullivan Winfree, Mary Josephine Brock, smallest child in front is Archie Marvin Winfree, twin to Artie Melvin Winfree who choked to death on a pea at 9 months of age. Archine Marvin Winfree was an Inspector, Washington, D.C. Police Department. He drove the lead car in Presidential Inaugurations in Washington, D.C. Retired from the Police Department in Washington, D.C. No children. Second child in front row & on right side of picture is Homer Clarence Winfree who worked for the Detroit Michigan Police Department for 11 years from 1925 – 1936, he quit the force after his partner was killed. He owned & operated the Winfree Bus Line which ran from Detroit, MI to McMinnville, TN.

Back Row: L to R: Children of Horace Sullivan Winfree & Mary Josephine Brock: Mary Jane Winfree, she married James Dunn. She died of TB. Boy in the middle, Benjamin Franklin Winfree “B.F.”

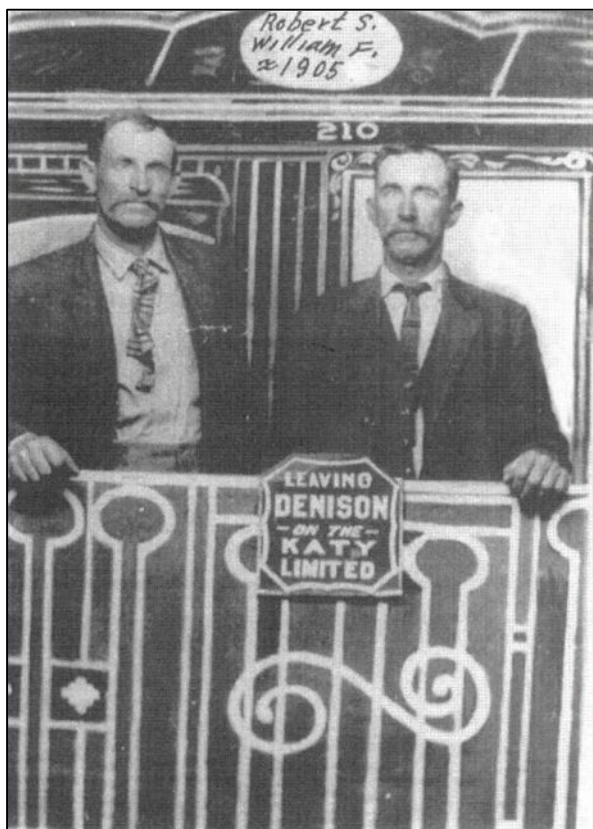
